Reduced membership fees for people receiving means-tested benefits

The club has to cover its costs but is keen that low income should not deter membership. The club thus offers half-price membership (based on the fee that would otherwise apply) to those who are in receipt of (or in the case of juniors live in households that are in receipt of) certain types of means-tested benefits. The benefits eligible for this concession are:

Income-based jobseeker's allowance
Income-related employment and support allowance
Income support
Pension credit
Working tax credit
Housing benefit
Council tax support
Universal credit

If any of these benefits entitles you to our fee concession, please attach evidence that you are receiving it to your application form. This information will be treated as strictly confidential: no-one except our membership secretary and treasurer will know that you are paying a reduced fee. If you need help with equipment or coaching fees, particularly for juniors, please ask the membership secretary, who will explore possibilities with the treasurer.
